Below are the installation instructions for inRoads 5.x. **If you already have a previous version of inRoads installed on your computer, you should first uninstall the previous version before installing this new version.** We've also included a brief history of all the major enhancements made during the release of version 1.x, 2.x, 3.x, 4.x and 5.x.

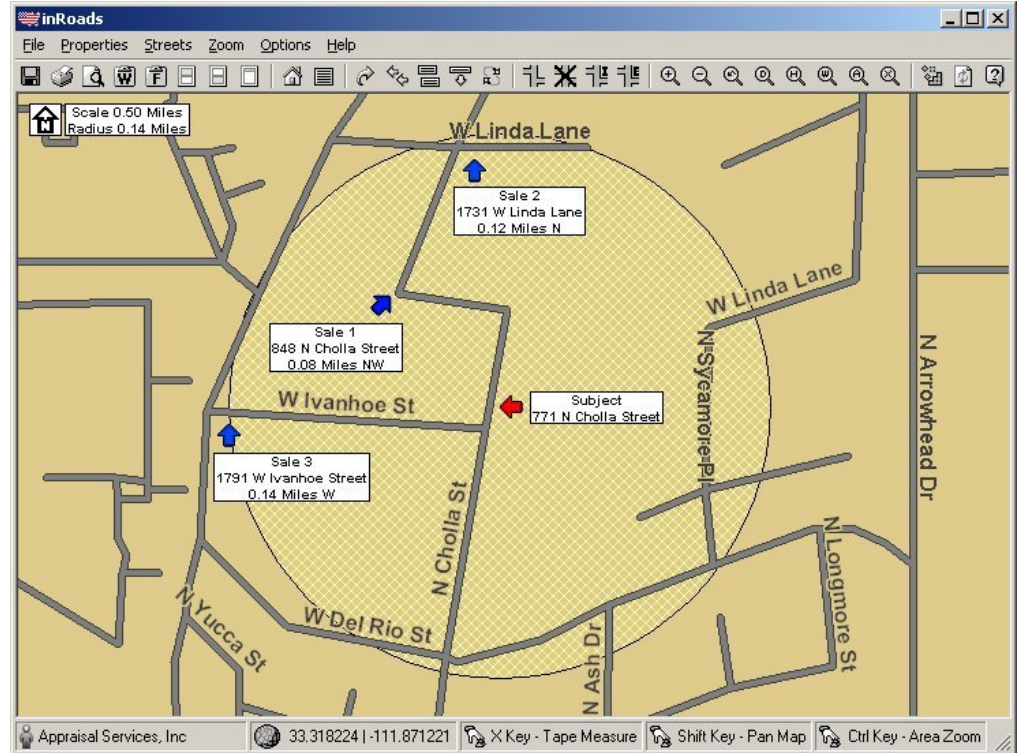

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



If you already have a previous version of inRoads installed on your computer, it is recommended that you first uninstall the previous version of inRoads before installing this new version.

To uninstall the previous version of inRoads, select "Settings" from the start menu. Next select "Control Panel". Then select "Add/Remove Programs". inRoads should be in the list of installed programs. Select inRoads in the listing and completely remove it.

inRoads 1.x Enhancement History

- Added the ability to turn on and off the questionable property warning message
- Increased total comparables from 9 to 12
- Set maximum "zoom in" to 528 feet or .10 mile
- Labels move when arrows are moved
- Turned on the street names to always appear when you see the street detail
- Enhanced address input file to recognize Sales, Listings and Rentals
- Updated the property warning message to display questionable properties in one dialog instead of a warning message for each questionable property

- Added ability in setup to create the map output file in color or black and white

- Lowered the "Find Address" score to 50 from 80 to initially plot more addresses
- Increased total comparables from 12 to 15
- Enhanced the location information tool tip
- Improved reading and writing of prior map data

- Added ability to render two maps on a single page

- Major roads stay visible out to 200 miles
- Enlarged street font for better readability
- Initial plotting of labels go under the arrows to the right
- Proximity info is exported even if the proximity is turned off on the labels

inRoads 4.x Enhancement History

- Added option to convert labels to uppercase
- Added Map Color option "Color (with white background)"
- Added Map Color option "Grayscale" – replaces B&W
- Added ability to store custom user labels
- Added ability to pan map and area zoom without holding down the keys
- Street detail goes out to 90 miles instead of 14 miles
- Updated and added some icons
- All message boxes are centered within the parent for window
- Land Sales now have their own arrow color
- Added white space between the 2 maps when using the 2 maps on 1 page option
- Enhanced draw streets to use [Z] key for drawing straight lines between point clicks
